Selection Criteria

To be accepted into the ESAP program, applicants must demonstrate:

- Sporting achievement and performance
- Commitment to training and improving performance
- Commitment to achieving personal academic goals
- Sportsmanship and positive attitude
- Commitment and contribution to the school community, including behaviour that reflects the school values
- The ability and willingness to commit time and effort to the program
- Very good attendance, effort and behaviour evidenced in report cards

Limited Spots

This program will be open to a limited number of students from Year 7 through to Year 12. Currently enrolled students may apply by completing an application form. Prospective students also need to submit copies of their two most recent school reports.

How to Apply

- Students must submit an ESAP application form, supporting documents, as well as attend the trial on the nominated date. Attendance at the ESAP trials will provide an opportunity for students to demonstrate the physical capabilities outlined in their application form to assist in selection.
- Continuation in the program will be subject to review on a regular basis. Students are required to pay an annual resource fee for enrolment in this program.
